NOMINATIONS ARE HEREBY REQUESTED

For **Region Director** of the following Regions: **Oregon, Mt Hood and Northwest.**

Any registered patroller in good standing may submit nominations for their respective region; an eligible candidate may also announce his or her own candidacy.

Nomination deadline is January 27, 2010

A nomination or announcement must be accompanied by a one-page resume of the candidate's membership in NSP which demonstrates the candidate's eligibility for office, and may be accompanied by a one-page statement of the candidate's platform. A nomination also must be accompanied by a written acceptance of the nomination signed by the Nominee.

A summary of Eligibility Requirements for Region Director (PNWD Policies and Procedures)

1. Must be registered NSP member within the region.
2. Must have been a registered member of the NSP for at least five years
3. Must have held an NSP patrol office or served as a region, division, or national advisory committee chairman for at least two years.
4. Must be familiar with division and region policies and procedures, as applicable.

Newly elected Region Directors are expected to attend the PNWD Annual Spring Board Meeting. This will be held on April 24, 2010, location to be determined.

The Region Director for each region shall be elected by a vote of the Patrol Directors/Unit Representatives or other authorized representative of each Patrol within the Region who are in good standing. Each patrol within the region is entitled to one vote. The nominee receiving the most votes will be deemed elected. A sole nominee will be deemed elected by acclamation.
